



Fireworks Safety: Dos and Do Nots

DO

- Follow your local & state laws
- Have a sober adult light one firework at a time
- Keep children and other observers at a safe distance
- Keep fireworks out of children's reach
- Have a bucket of water nearby to dispose of fireworks

DON'T

- Allow children to handle fireworks--including sparklers--or pick up spent fireworks
- Point or throw lit fireworks at anyone
- Ever hold lit fireworks in your hand
- Consume alcohol or drugs when lighting fireworks
- Forget you can be held legally and financially liable for injuries caused by using fireworks

FIRST AID

1. Cool the burn with **cool** (not cold) water to stop the burning process
2. Remove all clothing and jewelry from the injured area
3. Cover the area with a dry clean sheet of loose bandages
4. Seek medical attention
